Terms of Engagement – Internship period of six (6) months.

1. AGRICULTURE INTERNS (25 POSTS)

a) Duties and Responsibilities

An intern at this level will work under a senior and more experienced officer in the performance of their duties pertaining to the directorate; Specific duties and responsibilities will entail collecting, collating agriculture information and inputting into the database; collecting and packaging of new and existing agricultural technologies for dissemination; and preparing draft crop production and national food security reports.
