VACANCY FOR THE POSITION OF MEMBER OF THE NATIONAL POLICE
SERVICE COMMISSION – ONE (1) POST**

Further to the advertisement for the above position that appeared in the Daily Nation and the Standard Newspapers of Monday 30th January, 2023, it is hereby clarified that the available vacancy of Member in the National Police Service Commission falls under Article 246(2)(a)(i) of the Constitution i.e. “a person who is qualified to be appointed as a High Court Judge”. Therefore, pursuant to the above provisions of the Constitution of Kenya and Section 5(1)(4) of the National Police Service Commission Act No.30 of 2011 (Revised 2020), the Selection Panel invites applications from suitably qualified persons for the position of Member of the National Police Service Commission.

For appointment as a Member of the National Police Service Commission, a person should:

- (a) be a citizen of Kenya;
- (b) hold a degree from a university recognized in Kenya;
- (c) (i) have at least ten (10) years’ experience as a superior court judge or professionally qualified magistrate; **OR**
 - (ii) have at least ten (10) years’ experience as a distinguished academic or legal practitioner or such experience in other relevant legal field; **OR**
 - (iii) hold the qualifications specified in (i) and (ii) for a period amounting, in the aggregate, to ten years;
- (d) meet the requirements of Chapter Six of the Constitution;
- (e) not be and has not previously been a member of the National Police Service; and
- (f) have had a distinguished career in his/her respective field.

DISQUALIFICATION CRITERIA

A person shall not be qualified for nomination as a Member of the National Police Service Commission if the person:

- (a) is or has, at any time within the previous five years, been a Member of Parliament or a County assembly;
- (b) is a serving State Officer;
- (c) is a member of a governing body of a political party;
- (d) is an undischarged bankrupt;
- (e) has been convicted of a felony; or
- (f) has been removed from office for contravening the provisions of the Constitution or any other law.

(NB. Criteria No. (a) above shall cease to apply to a person after one (1) general election for Parliament has been held since the person ceased to hold such office)

INTERESTED APPLICANTS ARE REQUESTED TO NOTE THAT:

1. The names of shortlisted candidates shall be published in the print media;
2. Shortlisted candidates will be required to present **originals** of the following documents during the interviews:
 - (a) National Identity Card;
 - (b) Academic and Professional Certificates and transcripts;
 - (c) Any other supporting documents and testimonials; and
 - (d) **Current** and **Valid** Clearances from the following bodies:
 - (i) Kenya Revenue Authority;
 - (ii) Higher Education Loans Board;
 - (iii) A Registered Credit Reference Bureau;
 - (iv) Directorate of Criminal Investigations (Police Clearance Certificate);
 - (v) Printed Online Self-declaration Application Acknowledgement Receipt or a Self-Declaration Form duly stamped by the Ethics and Anti-Corruption Commission; and
 - (e) Recommendations from relevant professional bodies (where applicable).
3. The salary and benefits for this position shall be as determined by the Salaries and Remuneration Commission; and
4. The Member of the Commission will be appointed for a single term of six (6) years and shall not be eligible for re-appointment.

MODE OF APPLICATION

- (a) Candidates may apply manually or electronically (online).
- (b) All applications should be submitted together with detailed curriculum vitae, a copy of ID/Passport, copies of professional and academic certificates and transcripts, testimonials and any other relevant supporting documents.
- (c) Manual applications should be submitted in a sealed envelope clearly marked "Application for **Member** National Police Service Commission" and delivered to
